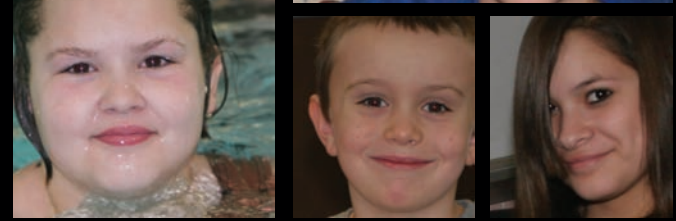

A LEGACY FOR OUR CHILDREN

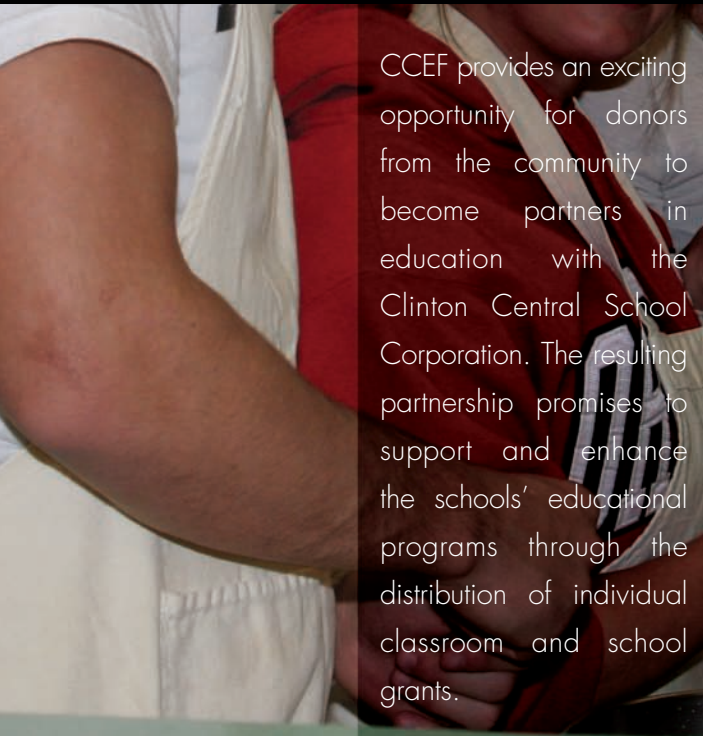




The Clinton Central Education Foundation (CCEF) was formed in 2007 with the purpose of helping the Clinton Central Schools enrich student learning.

WHERE DOES MY MONEY GO?

IS MY DONATION TAX-FREE?

Yes. The CCEF fund is managed by the Clinton County Community Foundation, a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, which allows all donations to be tax deductible according to IRS regulations.
